- Spring Short Course report – Lowell & Susan attended on 3/30/26
 - Roads have to be maintained on a regular maintenance or Township could lose them.
 - Once a month on minimal maintenance roads
 - Every two weeks for roads that are not dust guarded
 - 4-5% crown grade
 - Landlocked parcels – township can force an easement
 - Best for all parties to come up with an agreement
 - Townships can lose financial support if Financial Reports are not filed by 3/31/26
