

March 2026

The Regular Meeting for Candor Township was held 7 pm, March 9th, 2026, at Candor Town Hall. Brad Syltie opened the meeting at 7 P.M. Present were Brad Syltie, Lowell Bradbury, Bruce Moe, Ryan Hansen and Sharon Sauer. Visitors were Kyle Meachem, Marie and Duane Fillipi.

Lowell made a motion to approve the February minutes, seconded by Bruce. Brad made a motion to approve the audit minutes, seconded by Lowell, and Lowell made a motion to approve the absentee ballot board meeting minutes, seconded by Brad. Brad made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, Bruce seconded the motion. Ryan stated the six month CD is due this week and he will talk to the bank about the interest rate. Motions passed, 3-0.

Kyle Meachem from Minnesota Multimedia introduced himself and presented ideas for setting up a Candor Township.gov website.

In order to apply for .gov the town needs a physical address. Brad made a motion to have Ryan buy a locked mailbox for Candor Hall and call Frazee post office to arrange for mail delivery to Candor hall, seconded by Bruce.

The roads are in good condition, Torey was going to put sand on icy areas today, instead he graded areas to break up the ice. There is a fair amount of open roads with the recent warm weather. Two areas of concern is an area by Hook Lake where water from the ditch is threatening to run over the road. There was discussion on whether there was a culvert in that location or not. The other area was on Candor Hall road in a low area near Trowbridge Lake that has a culvert but keeps sinking, then when it thaws it comes up again, but needs gravel every year.

Brad discussed an estimate from APEX on tarring Candor Hall Road from County Highway 17 to 100 feet past 315th. Most of our roads have rocks and heavy clay so they would have to be reworked to make them ready to receive tar. Then that area would probably need 10 " not 8 " of tar due to loaded gravel trucks frequently using that road as a short cut. No motions were made.

Brad reviewed the terms of Torey's contract for snowplowing and grading. Lowell made a motion to approve the three year contract, seconded by Bruce. Sharon will mail the contract to Torey for his signature.

Brad presented a Resolution Establishing a Blacktop Paving Policy to the board. Lowell made a motion to approve and sign it, seconded by Bruce.

Bruce, Lowell and Sharon attended the East Otter Tail County Township meeting at Thumper Pond. Bruce reviewed the highlights for the board.

Dust guard prices reviewed from two providers, (Fergus Power Pump Inc, Corbin Excavating, Inc).

Brad made a motion to go with Fergus Power Pump who will provide calcium chloride, which was seconded by Bruce. Lowell volunteered to call and order around 60,000 gallons and arrange for approximate dates of delivery.

At the end of the month, there is a weed meeting at the East O. T. Soil and Water Conservation Office in Perham, Bruce and Lowell will attend.

Lake Region Electric asked permission to bore an electric line under Leek Lake Road. Brad made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Lowell.

Supervisors reviewed mail. See attached sheet for the claims that were approved.

The Board of Appeal and Equalization will be Wednesday, April 8th, at Candor Hall at 9:30 am.

Lowell and Bruce are certified for the Board of Appeal and Equalization.

Brad made a motion to adjourn at 8:40 pm seconded by Bruce. Vote 3 – 0.
